In the past years Chi Sigma Phi had remained a local group, but with the expansion at the university and the influx of our-of-state students, the thought of national affiliation began to grow. This past May with the slate of new officers beginning their term, definite steeps were taken to study this matter thoroughly and determine whether thin now mould prove advantageous. After thorough consideration Theta Tau was chosen and the movement began. In October, 1963 the membership voted unanimously to petition Theta Tau. The petition was approved in the latter part of Januery, 1964.

We, the brothers of Chi Sigma Phi, look forward with great enthusiasm to this association and hepe that we can live up to the confidence shown in us by our

future brothers of Theta Tau.
