Chi Sigma Phi was organized as an Engineering Social Fraternity on March 20, 1922 at the University of Detroit with twelve charter members. It is the third oldest fraternity on campus, having had some 400 members among the graduates from the university.

Through the years the fraternity has been extremely active in university activities both in the engineering college as well as in all other campus events.

In the past years Chi Sigma Phi had remained a local group, but with the expansion at the university and the influx of our-of-state students, the thought of national affiliation began to grow. This past May with the slate of new officers beginning their term, definite steps were taken to study this matter thoroughly and determine whether this move would prove advantageous. After thorough consideration Theta Tau was chosen and the movement began. In October, 1963 the membership voted unanimously to petition Theta Tau. The petition was approved in the latter part of January, 1964.

We, the brothers of Chi Sigma Phi, look forward with great enthusiasm to this association and hope that we can live up to the confidence shown in us by our future brothers of Theta Tau.

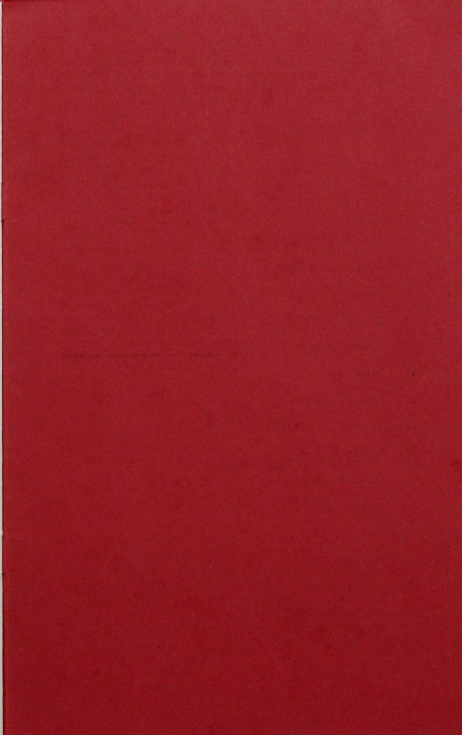
