HISTORICAL OUTLINE

- 1821-Columbian College established.
- 1873-Name changed to Columbian University.
- 1884—Corcoran School of Science and Arts, later Corcoran Scientific School, established as part of Columbian University.
- 1904—Name changed to "The George Washington University."
- 1906—Washington College of Engineering established as division of Department of Arts and Sciences, with Dr. H. L. Hodgkins as Dean.
- 1924-Student branch A. S. M. E. organized.
- 1927—Phi Theta Xi, Professional Engineering Fraternity organized.

 Student branch of A. S. C. E. organized.
- 1928—In reorganization, became The School of Engineering of The George Washington University.
- 1929-First Annual Engineers' Banquet held.
- 1930—The George Washington University accredited by the Association of American Universities.
- 1932—Student branch of A. I. E. E. organized. Engineers' Council organized, composed of Phi Theta Xi, A.S.M.E., A.S.C.E., and A.I.E.E. First Annual Engineers' Ball given.
- 1933—First Annual Phi Theta Xi Activities Plaque awarded
 1934—Petition of Phi Theta Xi to Theta Tau.
- 1935—Installation of Phi Theta Xi as Gamma Beta Chapter of Theta Tau.
